Assalamualaikum my Champions,

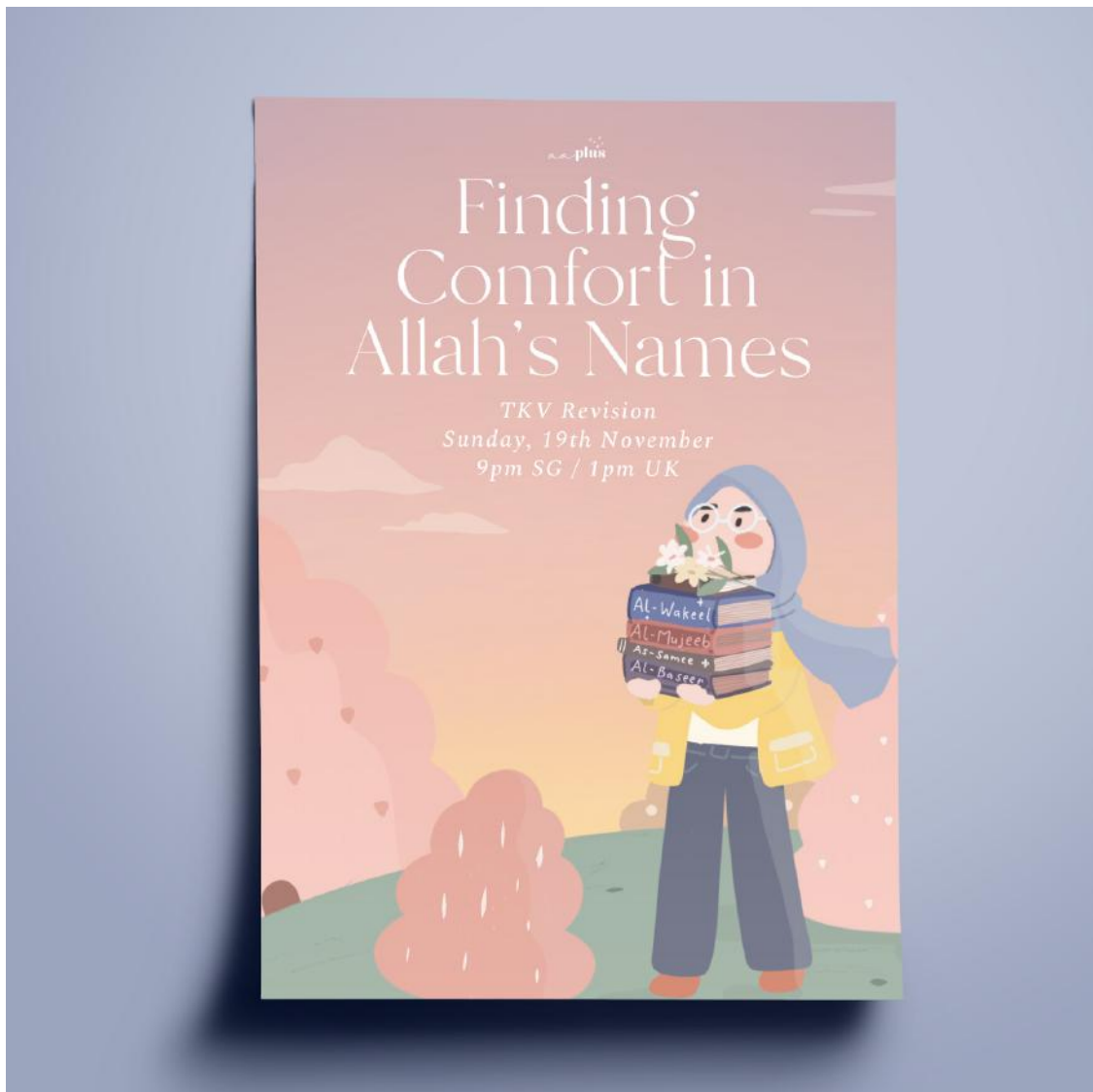

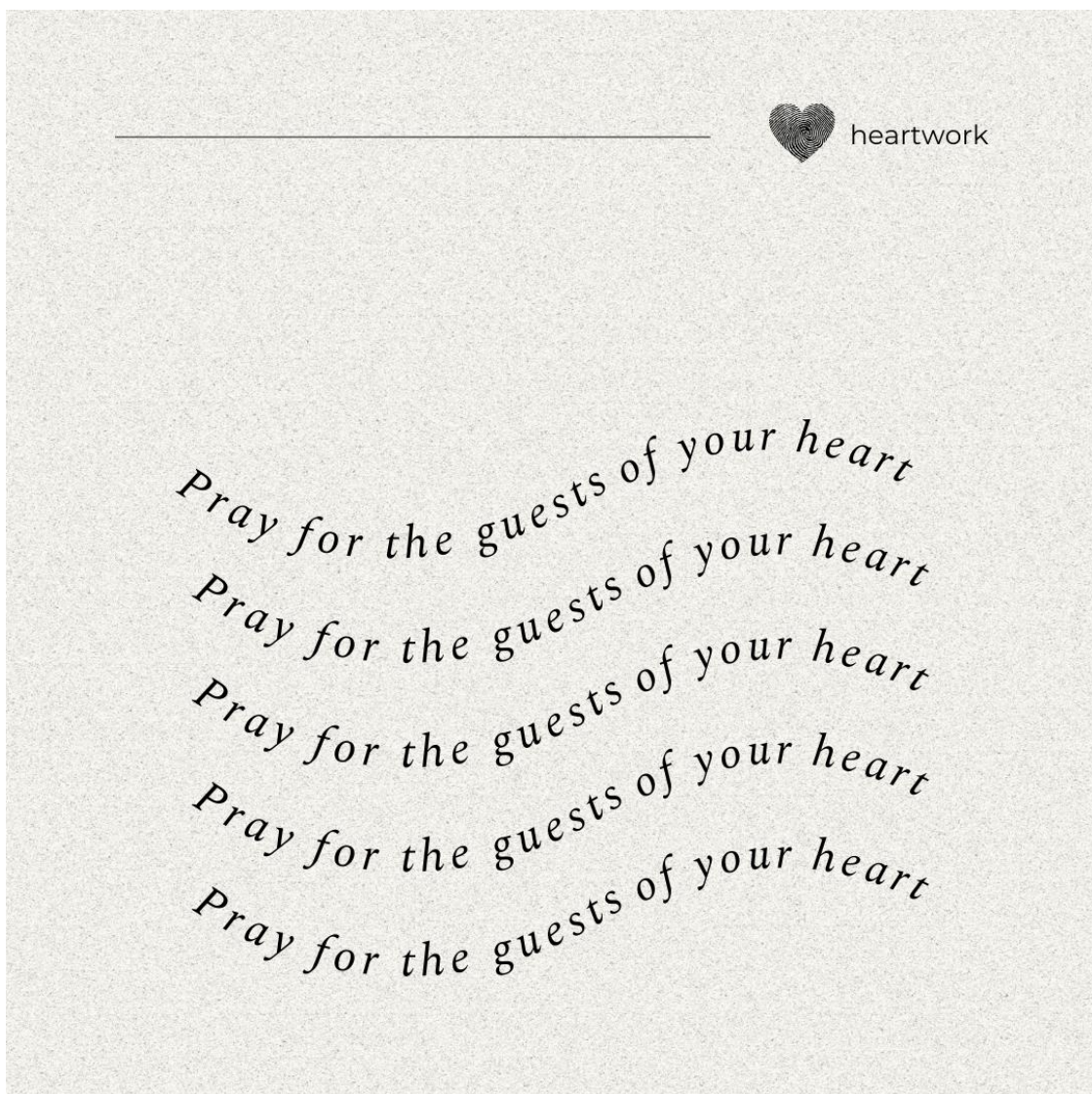

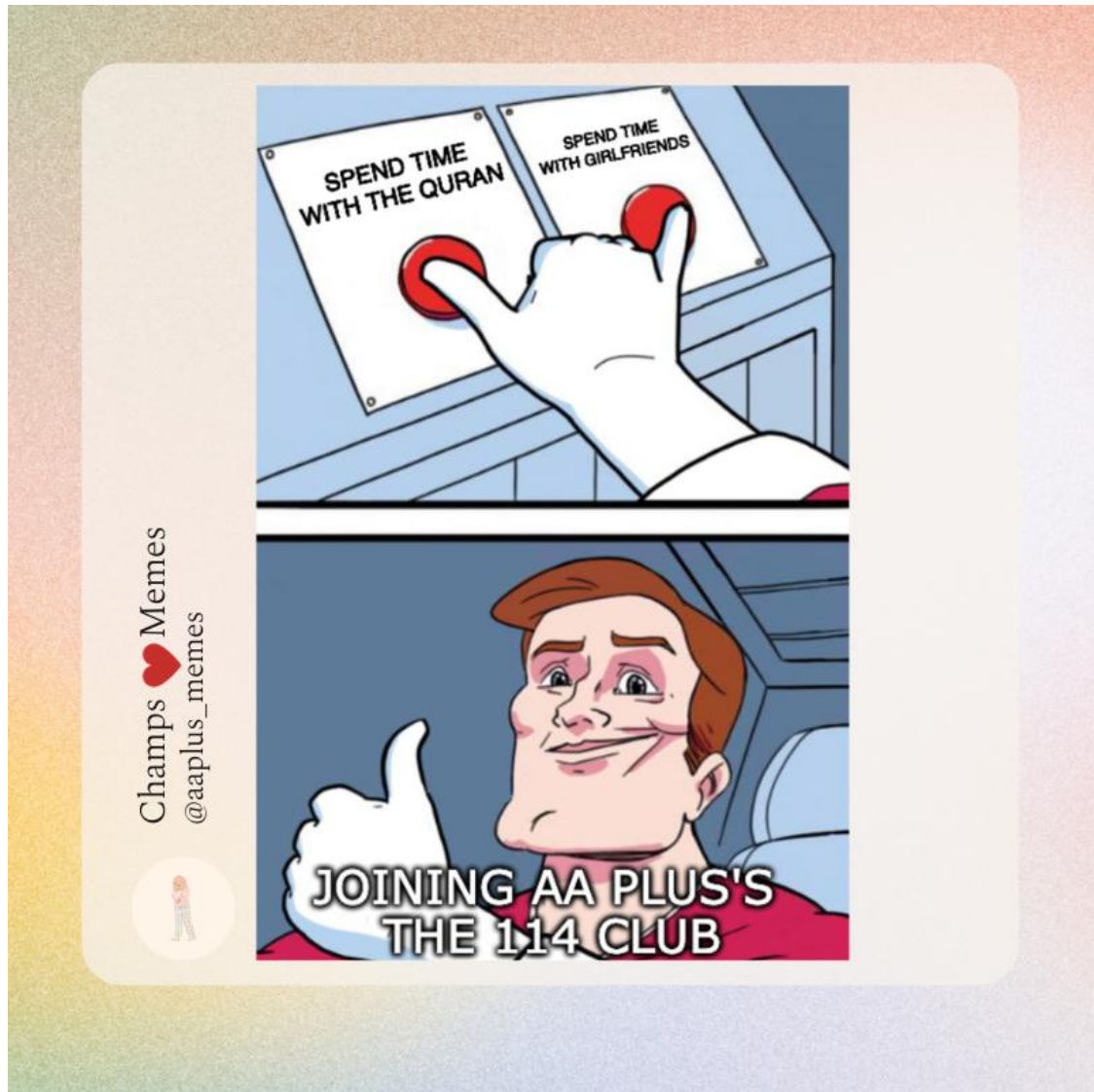
I don't know how many times I've received a text or an email, both from people I know personally and from readers of my love letters, telling me that they made a prayer for me, on days that I truly, truly,
