We worked around the clock until we were ready to re-open AA Plus again with the new website and features, and this was somewhere before Ramadhan.


Alhamdulillah, alhamdulillah, alhamdulillah, the new Sisters who joined us quadrupled in number to the ones we've lost and here we are,


The Unspoken Power of Emotional Intelligence
