

ETIQUETTEOF MAKINGDU'A



1. DO NOT BE HASTY

The Messenger of Allah heard a person supplicating during prayer. He did not mention the greatness of Allah, nor did he invoke blessings on the Prophet ...

The Messenger of Allah said: He made haste. He then called him and said either to him or to any other person:

If any of you prays, he should mention the exaltation of his Lord in the beginning and praise Him; he should then invoke blessings on the Prophet (ﷺ); thereafter he should supplicate Allah for anything he wishes.

(Sunan Abi Dawud 1481)

2. CALL ALLAH BY HIS NAMES

"To God belong the Best Names, so call on Him using them..." (Al-A'raf 7:180)



3. FACE THE QIBLA

The Prophet (ﷺ) went towards the Musalla and invoked Allah for rain. He faced the Qibla and wore his cloak inside out, and offered two rak`at. (Bukhari)



But when the Prophet was leading the prayer, he would turn to face the congregation after prayer: Sayyiduna Samurah ibn Jundub RA is reported to have said: 'Rasulullah used to turn around after completing the (Fard) salah and He would face us.' (Bukhari)

4. LOWER YOUR VOICE

We were in the company of the Prophet (ﷺ) on a journey, and whenever we ascended a high place, we used to say Takbir (in a loud voice).

The Prophet () said, "O people! Be kind to yourselves, for you are not calling upon a deaf or an absent one, but You are calling an All-Hearer, and an All-Seer." (Bukhari)



5. RAISE YOUR HANDS

The Prophet (ﷺ) said: Your Lord is munificent and generous, and is ashamed to turn away empty the hands of His servant when he raises them to Him. (Sunan Abi Dawud 1488)

6. MAKE DU'A FOR OTHERS

The Prophet (ﷺ) said, 'No Muslim servant supplicates for his brother behind his back but that an angel says, "And for you the same"' (Muslim)

7. HAVE CERTAINTY IN ALLAH

"Is it not He Who responds to the distressed one, when he calls on Him, and Who removes the evil." (An-Naml 27:62)

When the Messenger of Allah significantly finished his prayer, he would seek forgiveness from Allah three times and he would say,

BENEFITS OF ISTIGHFAR

Ibn Abbas reported: The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "Whoever increases his prayers for forgiveness, Allah will grant him relief from every worry, a way out from every hardship, and provide for him in ways he does not expect."

(Musnad Aḥmad)

O Allah, You are my Lord, there is none worthy of worship but You. You created me and I am your slave. I keep Your covenant, and my pledge to You so far as I am able. I seek refuge in You from the evil of what I have done. I admit to Your blessings upon me, and I admit to my misdeeds. Forgive me, for there is none who may forgive sins but You.

Whoever recites this with conviction in the evening and dies during that night shall enter Paradise, and whoever recites it with conviction in the morning and dies during that day shall enter Paradise.

PRAISING ALLAH SWT

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) used to say at the conclusion of prayer:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ، وَلَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ، وَلَا وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيءٍ قَدِيرٌ. اللَّهُمَّ لَا مَانِعَ لِمَا أَعْطَيتَ، وَلَا يَنْفَعُ ذَا الْجَدِّ مِنْكَ الْجَدُّ مِنْكَ الْجَدُّ

La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la syarika lahu, lahul-mulku wa lahul-hamdu, wa Huwa 'ala kulli shay-in Qadir. Allahumma la mani'a lima a'tayta, wa la mu'tiya lima mana'ta, wa la yanfa'u zal-jaddi minkal-jaddu.

There is no true god except Allah. He is One and He has no partner with Him, His is the sovereignty and His is the praise, and He is Omnipotent. O Allah! None can deny that which You bestow and none can bestow that which You hold back, and the greatness of the great will be of no avail to them against You.

CELEBRATING ALLAH SWT

La ilaha illa allahu wah dahu la shareeka laahu, lahul mulku wa lahul hamdu, wa huwa 'ala kullee shay'in qadeer, La hawla wa laqu-aata illah billah, la ilaha illAllah wala na'budu illayyah, lahunni'matu, wa lahul fadl, wa lahu-saana ul hasanu, la ilaha illAllahhu mukhliseena lahudeen, wa law karihal kafiroon.

There is no true god except Allah; He is One. To Him belongs the dominion & to Him is all praise, and He is Powerful over all things. There is no power and might except with (the help of) Allah. There is no God but Allah & we worship none except Him, to Him belongs the bounty & to Him belongs the grace, and to Him belongs all excellent praise; there is no deity but Allah. We reserve our devotion exclusively for Him though the disbelievers may detest it.

Ibn Az-Zubair said: The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) used to celebrate Allah's Greatness in those terms after every prayer.

REMEMBERING ALLAH SWT

Subhanallah, Walhamdulillah, Walllahuakbar

Glory is to Allah, and praise is to Allah, and Allah is Greater. (Each recited 33 times)

La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la syarika lahu, lahul-mulku wa lahul-hamdu, wa Huwa 'ala kulli shay-in Qadir

There is no true god except Allah. He is One and He has no partner with Him, His is the sovereignty and His is the praise, and He is Omnipotent.

Whoever says this after every prayer will be forgiven his sins even though they be as the foam of the sea. (Muslim)



SALAWAT ON THE PROPHET

اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَىٰ سَيِّدِنَا مُحَمَّدٍ وَعَلَىٰ آلِهِ وَصَحْبِهِ وَسَلَّمْ

Allahumma salli 'ala Sayyidina Muhammadin wa 'ala alihi wa sahbihi wa sallim

O Allah, send prayers and peace upon Muhammad and upon his Family and Companions.

"Verily, the supplication is suspended between the heavens and the earth. Nothing ascends from it until you send blessings upon your Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him."

(ﷺ).' Then the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ)
said: 'Never forget to say in every prayer
(the above du'a)."

The Messenger of Allah على used to say:

Bismillahi al-ladhi la yadurru ma'a ismihi shay'un fi alardi wa-la fi al-sama'i wa-huwa al-sami'u al-'alim.

In the Name of Allah, with Whose Name nothing is harmed on earth nor in heaven, and He is the All-Hearing, the All-Knowing. (Repeat three times)

"Whoever repeats, 'In the Name of Allah, with Whose Name nothing is harmed on earth nor in heaven, and He is the All-Hearing, the All-Knowing' three times [in the evening] will not be stricken with a sudden affliction until he reaches the morning. And whoever repeats this three times in the morning will not be stricken with a sudden affliction until he reaches the evening."



THE MOST REPEATED ADHKAR



La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la syarika lahu, lahul-mulku wa lahul-hamdu, wa Huwa 'ala kulli shay-in Qadir.

There is no true god except Allah. He is One and He has no partner with Him, His is the sovereignty and His is the praise, and He is Omnipotent.

Allah will write ten Hasanaat (rewards) for whoever recites this ten times in the morning, and forgive him ten misdeeds and give him the reward of freeing ten slaves and protect him from Satan. Whoever recites this ten times in the evening will get this same reward.

DU'A OF PROPHET YUNUS



لَا إِلَهَ إِلاَّ أَنتَ سُبْحَنَكَ إِنِّي كُنتُ مِنَ الظَّلِمِينَ

La ilaha illa anta subhanaka inni kuntu minaz-zalimin

"There is no god 'worthy of worship' except You. Glory be to You! I have certainly done wrong."

(Al-Anbiya 21:87)

The Prophet said that no one supplicates with this du'a except that his supplication is accepted. And nobody supplicates with it except that Allah removes his difficulties.

DU'A FOR BENEFICIAL LIFE

Allahumma innee as-aluka ilman nafi'a, warizqan tayyiba, waAAamalan mutaqabbala.

O Allah, I ask You for knowledge which is beneficial and sustenance which is good, and deeds which are acceptable.

It was narrated from Umm Salamah that when the Prophet (ﷺ) performed the Subh (morning prayer), while he said the Salam, he would say the above du'a.

He 'fully' knows what is ahead of them and what is behind them, but no one can grasp any of His knowledge—except what He wills 'to reveal'. His Seat encompasses the heavens and the earth, and the preservation of both does not tire Him. For He is the Most High, the Greatest.

VERSES OF PROTECTION

'Abdullah bin Khubaib (May Allah be pleased with him) reported:

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said to me,

"Recite Surat Al-Ikhlas and Al-Mu'awwidhatain (Surat Al-Falaq and Surat An-Nas) three times at dawn and dusk. It will suffice you in all respects."

(Abu Dawud and At-Tirmidhi)
