"Indeed, the number of months ordained by Allah is twelve—in Allah's Record since the day He created the heavens and the earth—of which four are sacred."

Surah at-Tawba: 36





Rasulullah explained in a hadith what these 4 sacred months are:

"Three of them are in succession: Dhul-Qa'dah, Dhul-Hijjah, Muharram and **Rejab** of (the tribe of) Mudar".

The month of Repentance.

Why do we need to repent & seek forgiveness from Allah SWT?





Because Allah said so!

O you who have believed, repent to Allah with sincere repentance. Perhaps your Lord will remove from you your misdeeds and admit you into gardens beneath which rivers flow [on] the Day when Allāh will not disgrace the Prophet and those who believed with him. Their light will proceed before them and on their right; they will say, "Our Lord, perfect for us our light and forgive us. Indeed, You are over all things competent." (At-Tahrim 66:8)



The Prophet made repentance a daily habit!



Narrated Abu Huraira (ra):
I heard Allah's Messenger saying.
By Allah! I ask for forgiveness from
Allah and turn to Him in repentance
more than seventy times a day."

(Bukhari)



It polishes the heart!



Abu Hurairah narrated that the Messenger of Allah said: "Verily, when the slave (of Allah) commits a sin, a black spot appears on his heart.

When he refrains from it, seeks forgiveness and repents, his heart is polished clean. But if he returns, it increases until it covers his entire heart.

(Tirmidhi)



7 more reasons to repent & seek forgiveness

(according to the Quran & Hadith)



"If anyone constantly seeks pardon (from Allah), Allah will appoint for him a way out of every distress and a relief from every anxiety, and will provide sustenance for him from where he expects not." (Abu Dawud).



Al-Zubayr reported: The Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "Whoever would love to be pleased with his record, let him increase seeking forgiveness on it." (Al-Abani)



"Saying, 'Seek your Lord's forgiveness, 'for' He is truly Most Forgiving. He will shower you with abundant rain, supply you with wealth and children, and give you gardens as well as rivers." (Nuh 71:10-12)





"But Allah would never punish them while you 'O Prophet' were in their midst. Nor would He ever punish them if they prayed for forgiveness." (Al-Anfal 8:33)



"And O my people, ask forgiveness of your Lord and then repent to Him. He will send [rain from] the sky upon you in showers and increase you in strength [added] to your strength." (Hud 11:52)




"Glad tidings to those who have excessive 'seeking forgiveness' in the record of their deeds." (Ibn Majah)



Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him said, "Verily, Allah SWT is more delighted with the repentance of His slave than a person who lost his camel in a desert land and then finds it (unexpectedly)". (Riyadh as-Salihin)



Most importantly, we seek forgiveness because we are human and we commit sins on a daily basis, both minor and major.





"If you were not to sin, Allah would surely create people who would sin and He would forgive them."

(Muslim)



What are the ways to repent & seek forgiveness?





STOP, DROP & ROLL Your 3-Step Tawba Plan

When we encounter a fire, we are taught to <u>'Stop, Drop and Roll'</u>. This is what we apply to repentance from sins too.



STOP

Our sins is the fire, so what we should do first is to **stop the sin**. We should make a vow and make sincere intention to not do it again.

DROP

We should lower ourselves to the lowest place in front of Allah SWT and go into physical and spiritual Sujood - confess how much the sins are affecting us and how we do not want them in our lives anymore. This is where regret and remorse should come in, as the Prophet says: "Regret is repentance." (Sunan Ibn Majah)





We need to move away from the place of sins. Alternatively, we can also transform the space into a place of Ibadah! We can roll to safety by follow ing up sins with good deeds as the Quran says, "Surely good deeds wipe out evil deeds." (Hud 11:114)



The simplest and easiest way to repent is through the Dhikr of

Istighfar (Astaghfirullah)



'I seek forgiveness in Allah'.





Thawban reported:

When the Messenger of Allah , finished his prayer, he would seek forgiveness from Allah three times and he would say, "O Allah, You are peace and from You is peace. Blessed are You, Majestic and Generous."

(Muslim)

Sayyidul Istighfar: The Master of Forgiveness

اللهمَّ أَنْتَ رَبِّي لا إِلهَ إِلاَّ أَنْتَ خَلَقْتَنِي وَأَنَا عَبْدُكُ وَأَنَا عَلَى عَهْدِكَ وَوَعْدِكَ مَا اسْتَطَعْتَ أَعُودُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا صَنَعْتَ أَبُوءُ لَكَ بِنِعْمَتِكَ عَلَيَّ وَأَبُوءُ بِذَنْبِي فَاغْفِرْ لِي فَإِنَّهُ لا يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ إِلاَّ أَنْتَ

Allahumma anta Rabbi la ilaha illa ant, khalaqtani wa ana `abduk, wa ana `ala `ahdika wa wa`dika mastaṭa`t, a`udhu bika min sharri ma ṣana`t, abu'u laka bi ni`matika `alay, wa abu'u bidhanbi faghfir li fa'innahu la yaghfirudhdhunuba illa ant.





O Allah, You are my Lord, there is none worthy of worship but You. You created me and I am your slave. I keep Your covenant, and my pledge to You so far as I am able. I seek refuge in You from the evil of what I have done. I admit to Your blessings upon me, and I admit to my misdeeds. Forgive me, for there is none who may forgive sins but You.

Whoever recites this with conviction in the evening and dies during that night shall enter Paradise, and whoever recites it with conviction in the morning and dies during that day shall enter Paradise.

(Al-Bukhari)

Du'a of Prophet Yunus while in the belly of the whale

La ilaha illa anta subhanaka inni kuntu minaz-zalimin

"There is none worthy of worship except You, Glory to You, Indeed, I have been of the transgressors."

(Al-Anbiya' 21:87)

Dua for forgiveness and mercy

Rabbana zalamna anfusana wa-in lam taghfir lana watarhamna la-nakunanna minal-khasirin

Our Lord! We have wronged ourselves. If You do not forgive us and have mercy on us, we will certainly be lost. (Al-A'raf 7:23)



Dua for forgiveness and repentance

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ وَأَتُوبُ إِلَيْهِ

Subhaana-Allahi wa bihamdihi, Astaghfirullaha, wa atuubu ilaihi

Allah is free from imperfection, and I begin with praising Him. I beg forgiveness from Allah and I turn to Him in repentance. (Bukhari & Muslim)

Dua for forgiveness for all believers and protection from resentment

رَبَّنَا ٱغْفِرْلَنَا وَلِإِخْوَانِنَا ٱلَّذِينَ سَبَقُونَا بِٱلْإِيمَاٰنِ وَلَا تَجْعَلْ فِى قُلُوبِنَا غِلَّا لِّلَّذِينَ ءَامَنُواْ رَبَّنَآ وَلَا تَجْعَلْ فِى قُلُوبِنَا غِلَّا لِّلَّذِينَ ءَامَنُواْ رَبَّنَآ إِنَّكَ رَءُوفُ رَّحِيمٌ

Rabbana-ghfir lana wa li ikhwaninal-laziina sabaquuna biliman, wa laa taj-al fii quluubina ghillal-lil lazina aamanuu, rabbanaa innaka raufur-rahim

Our Lord! Forgive us and our fellow believers who preceded us in faith, and do not allow any resentments into our hearts towards those who believe. Our Lord! Indeed, You are Ever Gracious, Most Merciful.

Du'a for forgiveness and removal of bad deeds

Rabbana fa-ghfir lana zunuubana wa-kaffir anna sayyiaatina wa-tafawwafaa maal-abrar

Our Lord! Forgive our sins, remove from us our misdeeds, and grant that we join the righteous when we die. (Ali Imran, 3:193)

Du'a taught to Abu Bakr As-Siddiq

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي ظَلَمْتُ نَفْسِي ظُلْمًا كَبِيرًا وَلَا يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ فَاغْفِرْ لِي مَغْفِرَةً مِنْ عِنْدِكَ وَارْحَمْنِي إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ الْغَفُورُ الرَّحِيمُ

Allahumma inni zalumtu nafsi zulman kathiran, Wala yaghfiru dh-dhunuba illa anta, fa ghfir li maghfiratan min `indika, wa r-hamni, innaka anta l-ghafuru r-rahim

O Allah! I have done great injustice to myself and none except You forgives sins, so bestow on me a forgiveness from You, and Have Mercy on me, You are the Forgiver, the Merciful. (Bukhari)

7 Simple Actionables You Can Do in Rejab

O1 Strive to pray earlier even if by a minute.

Stay longer on your prayer mat after
Solah to do your Zikir and Duas, even if for a minute.

03

Protect your mornings by checking in with Allah first, instead of with your phone.

04

Cut down on shows, shopping, music, even if it's by one show / item / song. 05

Oncrease on Quran, Zikir, Charity, even if it's by one Ayah / Dua / Dollar.

06

Embrace silence, slowing down and solitude. It's hard to hear what Allah is trying to teach us if we are always in a rush.

07

Let Istighfar be your closest companion and repeat it in abundance.
